The power of divine intelligence gives you a business capacity without limitation, an acuteness and comprehension, a perception of character and clear-cut systematic knowledge which leads to success. Truth reflected by you attracts to you trade from all channels of good. There is no fear, sickness, envy, doubt, anxiety, hate, or jealousy.

The discordant conditions of business have no power over you. You have no power to attract them. The divine Mind is yours to draw from and execute with, to bring out in your business harmony, success, and prosperity. There is no unrest, discord, fear, or friction; no weakness, discour-

agement, uncertainty, or failure. You have an inexhaustible supply. There is no avarice, greed, trust in money, or love of money. You have abundant proof of God's loving care and His law of supply.

You live in the land of promise. God has called you out of any sojourn in Egypt (in darkness), to return to your own country and inheritance. The days of hunger, famine, thirst are past. God is substance, Principle, Life. Man as His image reflects the capabilities and possibilities of Spirit.

You live in Mind, in the atmosphere of plenty. There is no power or presence that can resist good or prevent your prayer from being answered, from being effectual. While you remain in this frame of mind, you are obedient to the Principle of your being, and naught can hinder your healing the sick and the sinning.

Mrs. Eddy told me of a demonstration that took place, when the roof of The Mother Church was being put on. It did not rain for about sixty days. Finally, the milkman left word at Pleasant View that he would be unable to bring any more milk, since there was not enough water in his well for his cows, and they were drying off. The next day, however, he came as usual with the milk, saying there were two or three feet of water in his well, despite the fact that it had not rained. He asked the students who met him, if they were witches or prophets.

After telling this demonstration Mrs. Eddy said, "Isn't God good? Oh! Mr. Carpenter, trust in the dear, good God."

In II Kings 3:17 we read, "For thus saith the Lord, Ye shall not see wind, neither shall ye see rain; yet that valley

shall be filled with water, that ye may drink, both ye, and your cattle, and your beasts." It would seem that Mrs. Eddy's demonstration in the above case was a present-day fulfillment of this Scriptural prophecy.



Possession

Practice having a sense of possession of all things. Taking possession of what God gives us is the step leading to God giving us what we desire. If you take possession of what is at hand for you, it becomes the loaves and fishes for you, the basis of multiplication. Jesus' first question was, "How many loaves have you?" You must first have the consciousness of something to multiply. Keep practicing "this is mine" until the spirit of possession is gained, and you will feel "all things are mine."

You must have a clear enough sense of possession to make others feel it. "All things that are the Father's are mine" means just what it says. Things that have no possessor, anyone can claim. This is a sense of the Kingdom of Heaven within that gives power and control. Conviction is dominion. As we argue this of possession we shall see that a sense of loss is not possible.

Mind is all that recognizes or experiences within itself all power, all ability, all achievement, all results. Let us rid ourselves of an outside world, and learn that we possess all things, and were given dominion. A sense of possession is as much a law of your being as the distinct sense of activity. Take possession of healing, of health, of demonstration, of results, of a sense of results. Let the results be what you decide and not what some other mortal thinks for you. Our land of Canaan lies before you. Let us go in and possess the land.

Indoctrination — Unconscionable in Science

As Heidi stated on the church website, "This is why I love Independent Christian Science: It teaches us 'how to think,' not, 'what to think!"

Who teaches this? One who does not speak beyond what he or she has proven, who points back to the Bible and Science and Health, who loves enough to correct and never to condemn.

The death-blow to the practice of Christian Science is indoctrination — "to teach to accept a system of thought

uncritically," as defined by Webster. Recently in our Sunday Roundtable, after several contributors described how they would deal with a specific type of problem, and what statements of truth (all excellent) they would use, one participant candidly admitted that, prior to his finding independent Christian Science, he "did all that and it never worked." This individual had grown up attending Christian Science Sunday School, attended Principia (a college for Christian Scientists), and yet his life was a living hell until he found Plainfield and began getting de-programmed!

Although other Christian denominations have their doctrines and creeds to define what they believe, Mary Baker Eddy never established such an organization or set of doctrines. The fact that Christian Science became a denomination known for "not believing in doctors" was the result of disobedience, not obedience to the vision and direction of Mrs. Eddy. The governing body of the Christian Science movement, the Board of Directors, fell into the trap of all ecclesiasticism by trying to protect the purity of the teaching, and by so doing, encouraging "the flock" to believe instead of to understand, to merely accept a doctrine instead of having the heart transformed. This has resulted in "confusion worse confounded."

The only way to "teach" others is by example, as Jesus did. Jesus' life taught mankind to love God and our neighbor as ourselves, to thank Him, to turn to Him for guidance, etc. From this standpoint, Christian Science makes perfect sense, as we put off our "human," selfish ways, and rely more and more on that inner voice, that spiritual sense instead of the physical. We begin to see that life as the world sees it is full of self-destructive contradictions, and that Science makes a lot more sense and really opens up the doors of hope and opportunity.

To teach anyone, especially a child, to believe that

there is no matter, no evil, and no sin, that these are unreal, is a very dangerous thing to do. It leads to the kind of practice that Mrs. Eddy warned against in the textbook: "If Christian healing is abused by mere smatterers in Science, it becomes a tedious mischief-maker. Instead of scientifically effecting a cure, it starts a petty crossfire over every cripple and invalid, buffeting them with the superficial and cold assertion, 'Nothing ails you.'" This includes the parent "teaching" their child. The pure thought of a child is not favorably impressed by talking and not doing!

Our textbook says it more clearly than we ever could: "Emerge gently from matter into Spirit. Think not to thwart the spiritual ultimate of all things, but come naturally into Spirit through better health and morals and as the result of spiritual growth."

"If we would heal by the Spirit, we must not hide the talent of spiritual healing under the napkin of its form, nor bury the morale of Christian Science in the grave-clothes of its letter. The tender word and Christian encouragement of an invalid, pitiful patience with his fears and the removal of them, are better than hecatombs of gushing theories, stereotyped borrowed speeches, and the doling of arguments, which are but so many parodies on legitimate Christian Science, aflame with divine Love."

Someone recently said that before coming to our church, he would diligently spend time studying the Lesson each morning, close the books, and then get back to the busi-

ness of worrying! I found this very amusing, as it was something I could really relate to.

Years ago a practitioner gave me pages 390-393 from Science and Health to work with in order to break the worry habit, as well as for other problems. She referred to these pages as the "command statements" and suggested I underline all of them. If you refer to these pages, you will find quite a list including, "dispute the testimony," "suffer no claim . . . to grow upon the thought," "agree to disagree," "banish the belief," "mentally contradict." Mrs. Eddy goes on with mounting enthusiasm!

At first I was like the one mentioned earlier; it was very inspiring to read these pages and to receive a temporary high, but applying them in my daily life was a different matter. It took practice and determination to meet every negative suggestion with the Truth. When the suggestion of sickness would come, I determined to "mentally contradict every complaint from the body." As I consistently addressed every negative thought with as much God-given strength as I could muster, big changes began to take place. Sometimes it would be necessary to sing hymns — loudly! Sometimes it would be necessary to stamp my foot, but eventually error's hold on me loosened.

If you are feeling things are somehow not working out for you, give this your full attention! When studying the subject of mathematics, we must not only study the textbook, but we must also work out some problems. Is that not true? Every day we are confronted with problems and we have the priceless privilege to work each one out in Christian Science, with the help of Almighty God!

Follow Mrs. Eddy's instructions. When error is barraging you with all its negativity, call upon these command statements to rule error out of your existence! This is the Law of God. You can count on it to work!

Overcoming Inertia

Everyone has a constant need to guard against mental inertia. No matter how long we may have studied Christian Science, it's still vital that each day we strengthen our spir-

itual defenses. "All that error asks is to be let alone," says Mary Baker Eddy in her article, "Ways that are Vain." (My.) Over and over again in the teachings of Jesus and of Mrs. Eddy we find constant warnings to be alert. "I say unto you all, Watch," was the message given by Jesus to his disciples many times; and Mary Baker Eddy says in her Message to The Mother Church for 1900, "The song of Christian Science is, 'Work—work—work—watch and pray."

It is not enough to passively accept the truths of Christian Science; we must also vigorously deny the claims of evil. Jesus spoke with authority to every suggestion of sickness, sin, death, or worldly ambition which presented itself to him. He never hesitated to give a direct rebuke to the belief in fever, dumbness, or Pharisaism.

In this age, when there seems to be a majority on the side of materiality and the belief in the so-called power of human thought, there is much need for constant mental work. Again in Miscellany we read, "Unless one's eyes are opened to the modes of mental malpractice, working so subtly that we mistake its suggestions for the impulses of our own thought, the victim will allow himself to drift in the wrong direction without knowing it. Be ever on guard against this enemy. Watch your thoughts, and see whether they lead you to God and into harmony with His true followers."

An awareness of the methods and modes of evil must never be confused with fearfulness. Because this awareness is brought about by an understanding of God's allness and the absolute powerlessness of evil, it is endued with calm courage, conviction, and clear vision. It recognizes the source of all evil and knows it to be "a liar, and the father of it." It knows that a counterfeit has no reality, no substance, and no life. It realizes that thoughts which bear the fruits of ill health, ill will, fearfulness, and discontent —

however pleasantly they are arrayed in garments of well-meaning ignorance, time-consuming gossip, or mistaken legislation — are malicious, and should be conquered and proved powerless.

This spiritual alertness is the exact opposite of the mental inertia which allows graft, false propaganda, and selfish ambition to creep into politics, which drones on while immoral legislation is enacted, which remains in a purposeless state of rest while fear spreads an epidemic, and which is aroused only by desperate personal need. Spiritual alertness is aware that "an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure"; and those who are alert, give thanks daily for the preventive power of God-inspired thought.

To "pray without ceasing" is not to spend all our days on our knees in our closets, but to constantly keep thought actively engaged in accepting and affirming the true, spiritual understanding of man, and in firmly rejecting and denying all that is untrue, illegitimate, and inharmonious. To work and "watch and pray" is to prove ourselves guardians of mankind, and sentinels on the watch towers of spiritual light.

Assuredly, the great Master who bade his people "take therefore no thought for the morrow," knew that today's obedience will care for tomorrow. The Power of Our Textbook

Mrs. Eddy once instructed her students to turn to our textbook, Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures, for healing; and to turn to her other book, Prose Works, for instruction. I have found even one sentence from Science and Health to be rich with meaning and one that can be practically applied to daily life.

Recently the following statement was in our Lesson on Spirit: "Spirit is the Ego which never dreams, but understands all things; which never errs, and is ever conscious; which never believes, but knows; which is never born and never dies. Spiritual man is the likeness of this Ego."

I copied this sentence on an index card, kept it with me, and worked with it during the week in the following

Watching Point No. 70 Gilbert C. Carpenter

WATCH lest, in your effort to expose the nothingness of animal magnetism, either you make a reality of it, and hence become afraid of it, or else you ignore its claims to power and existence, which is equivalent to being handled by it. It is nothing, and it must be recognized as nothing. It must be proved to be nothing and it must be kept nothing; but this attainment must come through a knowledge of its operation, and not through ignoring it.

Watching Point No. 72, 73 Gilbert C. Carpenter

WATCH lest the quickening within yourself concerning animal magnetism, which comes with spiritual progress, be interpreted as an increase in its power, activity and subtlety, instead of the uncovering in your own thought of a latent fear of it, or belief in it. Error cannot be handled rightly and destroyed until one has traced all effect back to cause and recognized that, although the mesmerism comes from outside, the yielding to it lies within your own thinking. This is only another way of saying what Mrs. Eddy once declared, "Error comes to you for life, and you prolong its life by giving it a false temporary sense of Life."

Animal magnetism is the human mind on the way out, aroused to resistance by Truth.

Edward A. Kimball — The "Paul" of Christian Science

Andrew Kidd

As Paul was to the early Christian church, so was Edward A. Kimball to the early Christian Science movement. He delivered more than 1,800 lectures on Christian Science, requiring more than 400,000 miles of travel, without airplanes! His ability to communicate the message to those unfamiliar with Christian Science was unrivaled. His lectures filled every hall to overflowing. His love and respect for Mary Baker Eddy and her revelation was indisputable, as is evident from his lectures and other writings. And apparently, like Paul, he had his share of physical discomfort, which he never let stop him.

That Mrs. Eddy had the highest regard for Mr. Kimball and his grasp of Christian Science, right up to the end of his time here on earth, is supported by the fact that she asked him to teach the 1910 Normal Class. Prior to that class, when Mrs. Eddy survived the vicious attacks that came through the Next Friends Suit, she came to a much higher understanding of body, and she chose Mr. Kimball with whom to share it. Each evening for several hours, she would drill Mr. Kimball to make sure he got it correctly. Apparently feeling his own end was near, he chose three trusted associates, including his student, Bicknell Young, and shared with them this precious teaching, in turn drilling them late into the night. Mr. Kimball passed on before he was able to teach the Normal Class.

What was Mr. Kimball's earthly reward? After Mrs. Eddy passed, he (posthumously) and his students were marginalized by the Board of Directors, accused of corrupting Mrs. Eddy's revelation! Terms like "Kimballism" and "the Chicago School" emerged. Who was responsible

for this? It is safe to say, rather than getting into personalities, it was the Red Dragon from Revelation. What was the main point of contention? Essentially, Mr. Kimball declared that what we see as material things is a wrong way of interpreting what is actually before us. Correctly seen, the "material" thing (*i.e.*, organ of the body) is a spiritual idea. The "Red Dragon" crowd accused Mr. Kimball of corrupting Mrs. Eddy's teaching, insisting that the so-called material organ is nothing, and represents nothing.

This explains why, very often, Christian Scientists are the most confused people on earth. "The material universe is nothing and represents nothing, while Spirit is everything, but we seemingly have to live in the material." This has led, in practice, to a dualism that is fatal to the practice of Christian Science, and we have the Red Dragon, or unhandled animal magnetism, to thank for it.

We here celebrate that great worker, who arguably has done the most to spread Christian Science, aside from Mrs. Eddy herself, and conclude with this, her benediction after his passing: "My beloved Edward A. Kimball, whose clear, correct teaching of Christian Science has been and is an inspiration to the whole field, is here now as veritably as when he visited me a year ago. If we would awaken to this recognition, we should see him here and realize that he never died; thus demonstrating the fundamental truth of Christian Science." (My.)

Following are some quotes from the writings of Edward A. Kimball.

Philosophies have been wrecked in trying to account for the origin of evil. I would jump into the lake if I found the origin of evil, because then it would be true. There is no origin, source, or foundation for evil. "Two times two is five" is

a lie about "two times two is four." This silences error.

God is Good, and that means that every right idea carries with it the very power of the universe. A right idea will move a mountain, because it is entitled to do the deed, and there is no adequate competition and no rival by way of power that can stay or obstruct or interfere with it. God has no other law for us than Life.

Take courage of every experience, and power will be yours. Go on, dear friends, and prove that you are the children of Him who cares for His own. Be faithful to Principle in all you say and do, and success will be yours.

You are a law unto yourselves. Heaven is within. The kingdom of God is within. You have the power within — use it.

Perfect rightness in thought, word and deed is the real man. Evil is a wrong sense of a right thing. Human body is a counterfeit of the true body, the body of right ideas.

When you have a case of sickness, you have three specific features: one, that there is a claim, and that there is a substance to be sick; another, that there is a cause for the sickness; and lastly, that there is a law to cause that sickness. And unless you break the law, you are not handling the case.



What Is Law?

Everything that is, is because of God; and that which created the universe is its law. The law of God concerning you is the law of Life to you all the time, the law of health, the

law of strength, the law of enduring and continuing faculties, the law of your prosperity, your achievement, the law of your dominion; and there is no other law whatever in the universe. This is the only law there is, and there is no divine or natural law against you.

If you are sick, it is not because of law, but because of belief, ignorance, superstition and fear. God has not provided for your illness; there is no law that provides for it or procures it. There is a fable that, many years ago, a plague visited the city of Baghdad, and as a result ten thousand people died. Someone met the plague outside of Baghdad and reproached it for killing so many people. The plague answers, "You wrong me. I killed only one, and fear killed all the rest."

Operative Christian Science is the enforcement of law. Christian Science means the annulment of the so-called law of disease. Whenever a Christian Scientist heals a case, he does so by smashing a so-called law. Every demonstration of healing proves that disease is illegitimate and abnormal, and that the so-called laws governing it are abnormalities, having no intelligence, no right to exist, and no power of continuance.

There is no law that can bind you or bind upon you any hereditary disease. You may give up the belief now and forever that you are under the doom of any such law. God never provided for any such law. Declare in the name of Christ that you are under no ban, that you are healed, because you no longer need to be afraid of it, nor believe in it, nor expect it to master you. Be not afraid. You do not have to be afraid of anything. The law of being to you means dominion; and when you begin to exercise it, you will find that you have larger equipment.

The foundation of being is God and a divinely provided life for man and an eternal law for his life, health and

prosperity. Christ has abolished and always will abolish the so-called law of sin, disease, and death. You could not get away from the fundamental law of recovery to you if you tried. You only need to know that God's work is done, and that every provision necessary for your recovery has been made long ago, and that you are to stop believing something else.

A mortal cannot die out of the belief that body is material. He has got to live out of it. There is no way out of the belief of death, but to live!

Declaring What Is True

What we are lacking in is intelligence, faith, and confidence. Error will come up and declare that you do not realize the truth. What are you going to do about it? Are you going to say, "I don't realize it"? It is easy to wind Christian Scientists up, unless they wake up.

What is your Saviour? Is it, "I am discouraged; I cannot realize the truth"? Is it "I haven't enough confidence in my treatment"? But what is the one being saved going to do? He will declare, "I do realize the truth. It shall not return

void. It is the word of God, and I cannot be mesmerized to believe I have not confidence in it." That is what one who is being saved will know.

You must declare what is true about yourself, if you want to be saved in Christian Science. If the suggestion comes that says you cannot do it, declare that you *can* do it. Whenever error asserts itself, you have to declare that you are right. If it declares you cannot lift your arm, declare you can. God governs, and in the name of Science and in the name of law, you have the right to declare the perfection of everything about you, and only as you do it will you be governed by good. I would, therefore, say that your saviour is the right idea about everything. This is the Christ with us, the power and affirming of the right idea.

Don't stand around and say a few things and trust God to do the rest. He has done something. Bring out the facts of being and deny the error. You have got to do it. You sit around and say it is God's business to bring it out. He has already brought it out! You must manifest it by reflecting God. You have to do this and have faith in it. What you want to do is to know that every treatment is the very word of God. It is the power of good that destroys the fear of evil.

Reflecting the law of God is the enforced law of annihilation to the so-called law of false belief. Your treatment has to be big enough to know that it is the operation of the divine law breaking the so-called law of false belief.

A Christian Scientist can do nothing more than to bring the whole healing process into the mental realm and not submit to the belief that there is something to cure. It is not a material body, but a belief in it. It is like a rubber ball which has been squeezed out of shape. As soon as you let go of it, spontaneously, according to the law of resiliency, it comes back into shape. Just as soon as you break down the belief, the body will recover.

It is always sufficient and just; and God causes His infinite reflection to express His abundance. There can be neither lack nor stoppage of this infinite supply of good.

This realization of the true nature of work shows us that materiality does not own, give, or take away one's work, one's ability to work, or one's income; for these are all in Mind, and are sufficient and permanent. When this understanding is applied to the problems of employment, mankind will rise superior to the limitations of the material senses, and will bring, even into present experience, assurance, joy, progressive harmonious work, and the abundance of good.

The Kingdom of Heaven Is at Hand

Many people believe that the kingdom of heaven is a location to be found after death, or a state unattainable on earth. But Christian Science shows that this is not the case. The kingdom of heaven is neither a location nor is it unattainable. Both Christ Jesus and John the Baptist implored their followers, "repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." exalted state of consciousness. Jesus went one step further. He not only urged his followers to repent, but he demonstrated the kingdom of heaven by healing sickness, sin, and death. He taught his followers how to repent, and then promised that if we believe (understand the principle of his teaching), we will do the same, "and greater works than these."

The difference between John's career and that of Jesus illustrates a tendency of the human mind. When it is inspired, it can talk eloquently; but until it is put off entirely, it falls short of demonstrating its faith. It took the healing by Jesus and his disciples to get the attention of mankind to see the fallacy of relying on human theories and institutions, and the unlimited value of relying entirely on God for every need. James said, "shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works."

This is why Christian Science came to mankind when it did. The science of Christian healing had been lost — drowned by human institutions and motivated by the worst evil. There was a crying need that it be re-established in human consciousness, and divine Love, through Mary Baker Eddy, has once again met this need. Christian Science says to mankind: "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." And it shows us both in principle and in practice how to repent and to repeat the works of the Master.

Jesus referred to his demonstrations of healing as evidence of God's presence with men. Christian Science does likewise, for it is the same God and the same Principle at hand today as 21 centuries ago. Unless man experiences the healing of sin and disease, he has no practical evidence of the kingdom of heaven on earth, and is likely to drift into reliance on false, human systems rather than "love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength." Why did Jesus

urge his disciples to "go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand," unless he meant just what he said?

Christian Science teaches that true repentance is to forsake all reliance on anything other than God, and to put one's faith entirely in God. Today we have human systems covering all aspects of life — systems of education, of medicine, of religion, of government. And haven't we seen them fail to meet the higher needs of mankind? Don't they fail to produce health and harmony? Clarence Chadwick, a fine student of Mrs. Eddy, once wrote, "We should welcome the failure of all false human systems to bring health and harmony to earth, for these very failures can teach but one lesson, and that is, that the only real help comes from God."

The answer to these failures is not to replace one failed human system with another human system. It is to turn wholeheartedly to God and obey His law of divine Love, to be the image and likeness of the God who made us. Human government cannot "fix" these failures. That kind of thinking creates the problems we now face. We cannot help those who make mistakes by "bailing them out" or by softening the blow of bad decisions. We cannot improve health by requiring all citizens to subscribe to the material medical system. We cannot improve our lot by relinquishing individual freedom to a human hierarchy, whether in Boston, Rome, or Washington, D. C. We must allow those who make mistakes to live with the consequences of their mistakes, that they might repent (change from their reliance on false systems to reliance on God) and not repeat the mistake.

Only practical, demonstrative Christian Science, as taught and practiced by Christ Jesus, can save mankind from the dire effects of reliance on the human mind and its consistent failure to bring health and harmony. This is the only practical road to finding the kingdom of heaven on earth.
