THE LIGHT

I was very struck by the Golden text in the Lesson which mentions "light" twice, as well as Mrs Eddy's reference to "the Beam" and the "guiding star of being"

I looked up the definition of "Light" in Webster's 1828 dictionary which we know Mrs. Eddy used. It said,

"That flood of luminous rays which flows from the sun and constitutes day."

and "star" is defined as:

"An apparently small luminous body in the heavens, that appears in the night, or when its light is not obscured by clouds or lost in the brighter effulgence of the sun. Stars are fixed or planetary. The fixed stars are known by their perpetual twinkling, and by their being always in the same position in relation to each other. The planets do not twinkle, and they revolve about the sun. The stars are worlds, and their immense numbers exhibit the astonishing extent of creation and of divine power". ***********

That is beautiful! It brings to mind God's glory, which was in last week's Golden text, as well as this week's. I love to keep the sense of God's (magnificence, splendor) glory, in mind; it helps to appreciate all good and do all good for His glory.

When I make my whole purpose about showing God's glory, pretty soon error becomes so small in thought and vanishes.

Apparently the word "light" is mentioned 166 times in S and H and 235 times in the Bible...

Here are some of my favorites:

Psalms 119:105 Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.

Matthew 4:16 The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up.

Matthew 5:14 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.

Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

John 1:5 And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

John 8:12 Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life. ***********

It's just fascinating to me how Isaiah, the highest Christly thought of his time, foresaw the coming of Jesus (a great light!) several generations later. It's as though he knew what the world needed and that the world wasn't ready for it yet.

Then Jesus, the Master, gave to the world what it was ready for, but then foresaw the Comforter. He told his disciples, "I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now." He also knew what the world needed, and knew that it was not ready for the science yet.

When Mrs. Eddy discovered the Science of Christianity, she recognized it as the Comforter Jesus had prophesied, making it the final revelation of God to his creation. The Jewish "Messiah" has already fulfilled his mission. Jesus is not going to appear again in person, as many believe. We live in an exciting time. We have the Comforter, the Spirit of truth, in our very hands. Our great duty and privilege is to learn the Science and live it. *****

Error Is Without Intelligence or Reality

"The exterminator of error is the great Truth that God, good, is the only Mind, and that the supposititious opposite of infinite Mind — called devil or evil — is not Mind, is not Truth, but error, without intelligence or reality."

Intelligence means with understanding. Error is without intelligence or reality. It is dumb, a liar, and isn't real. Why do we listen to its lies? It doesn't say anything useful or helpful. It tries to pull us down. Error doesn't know anything!

We have the remedy. Replace these lies with the Truth and they exterminate the error. Exterminate means to destroy utterly; to drive away. It wipes out our belief in its reality. When it says, "I am sick" we can replace it with "God made man perfect." When it says, "we don't have time," we can replace it with, "I have time to do what God wants me to do." It is simple to wipe out the error because it is unreal and powerless! God, good, is the only Mind.

Two Reasons

I checked out the Greek and Hebrew words for "to believe" in my Strong's.

In the Hebrew the word for believe is "aman" and the same word is used for "to turn to the right" or "to go to the right hand."

So when Jesus told his disciples-fishermen to cast the net on the right hand, he actually told them to believe. The Hebrew synonyms seem to include: to build up, support, foster, render, to be firm, trust, to be permanent.

How important it is to make sure, when dealing with children, we transmit to them only what will bring them closer to the Father. On that same page in Science and Health (61), Mrs. Eddy also states, "What hope of happiness, what noble ambition, can inspire the child who inherits propensities that must either be overcome or reduce him to a loathsome wreck?" The care of children is indeed a solemn charge and to remember first and foremost that God is their Father-Mother and it is He alone to rely on for guidance. We are not frightened caregivers battling about on our own! God is our Creator and He governs His universe for He is Allin-all! ********
