Science and Health, p. 356 Does God Create a Material Man Out of Himself, Spirit?

I've contemplated this basic question a lot, as my previous beliefs had me quite confused about this point. I remember as a child imagining God going through the universe with a bag of atoms, taking some out here to make a star and some there to make a planet. How else but with such a childish thought can we rectify God with the human idea of materiality? I now can see two flaws with that idea:

- The first is that there was a need for that "bag of atoms." The substance God builds from is Spirit, and not matter.
- The second is that God does not wander about in the universe. He is the system within which our universe, our world, and our consciousness "live and move and have our being;" He is not some powerful being affecting it from within. This understanding shows me how absurd it is to think that a dense ball of matter exploded and then billions of years of accidents and false starts and evolution led to the universe, the Earth, and mankind. We teach small children that two wrongs don't make a right, and then later on school teaches them that trillions and trillions of wrongs eventually make up all that is right and good. THE EXCUSE-MAKING HABIT CLARENCE W. CHADWICK

Sentinel Feb. 13, 1909

"One who is learning to follow in the footsteps of the Master must constantly strive to correct and forsake his faults and not to excuse them. Blind faith or profession cannot bring about this practical putting off of "the old man"; it requires spiritual understanding. However plausible the excuse, it can never bring about reformation or regeneration.... Error, no matter in what form manifested, cannot be ignored, concealed, or smoothed over, but that it must be dealt with scientifically and at once."

I see now that this habit is disobedience and selfjustification which Mrs. Eddy tells us in Science and Health is, ".... the adamant of error, — selfwill, self-justification, and self-love, — which wars against spirituality." An excuse is not an antidote to mistakes, but makes it seem more real.

Jacob's Evil Twin?

On a practical level, this story is a wake-up call for me to allow neither whisper nor roar derived from the 5 tricksters, the corporeal senses to deter my footsteps up the mount of spiritual attainment, but rather to wrestle down and overthrow the mortal self that Jesus called out as a liar and the father of lies.

Mrs. Evans taught us to "demand the blessing" from every experience. No matter how tough or painful the experience may be, there is always a blessing in it, and we should always demand to be blessed by every experience we have. This is consistent with having a positive expectancy, whether we are in prison, in sickness, or in a bad relationship, we can and should demand the blessing from our wrestling, and not stop wrestling until we are blessed. ******

Powerless Unreality

Science and Health, p.6 Jesus uncovered and rebuked sin before he cast it out. Of a sick woman, he said that Satan had bound her, and to Peter he said. "Thou art an offence unto me."

Science and Health, p.234. We should become more familiar with good than with evil, and guard against false beliefs as watchfully as we bar our doors against the approach of thieves and murderers. Sin and disease must be thought before they can be manifested. You must control evil thoughts in the first instance, or they will control you in the second.

Whether evil appears as a physical claim or a character trait, am I saying "Get thee behind me" or "Thou art an offence unto me?" Or am I giving it audience with, "Oh! Why this" or "How did this happen." Either of Jesus' commands to the appearance of any claim denotes that I recognize its unreality and therefore its powerlessness? The fearful alarming questioning kind of response gets us into human reasoning; because we are already mesmerized, believing the evil is real and in the human mind we remain fearful looking for material justifications or material remedies.

Patient persistence in consistent uncovering and rebuking of sin, controlling thought to have the things of God dominant in our thinking is what gets us "familiar enough with good." Rejecting resentful thoughts, selfish ambitions, judging/condemning

others, favoring some and not others, forgiving, being compassionate, loving enough to warn of evil will all help the reflecting of the Christ Mind. And that Mind is a bar against evil, it recognizes it and repels it while being a citadel preserving the purity of one's thinking. **********

A Falling Away First!

"For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night. For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them. I have learned at this church that the voice of Truth and Love is constantly speaking to us through our spiritual sense.

I have also seen how the 'voice' of error lifts itself up, trying to drown out our spiritual sense, to confuse and mislead.

I have lifted my voice for the right reasons, and also lifted it for the wrong. I have seen that people want to do good. They want to be on the side of right, but sometimes have no idea how to start. I know that was true of me, and after years of searching, I began to feel that perhaps there was no right. In that place, it is easy to look to the narrow confines of your family, friends, and culture to try to determine what is right. That rarely works out all that well, unless God is the focus!

In this story of Joseph, it seems that in a culture that valued power and the people who possessed it, the master's wife felt her only way to get ahead was to gain more of that power through "acquiring" Joseph. Likewise, in a culture that values complaining, people will seek to complain and disrupt more. In a culture that values money, they seek more money.

I am grateful that this church has a culture that values God, unity, and service, because that helps newcomers to understand exactly what must be done to move forward. If that newcomer arrives and does not "fight the system" then they are set up to move forward in a right way. Eventually, the benefits of what this church has, what authentic Christian Science has, will be obvious and one will do right because it is right by God, and not just right within the culture of the church.

I also think it is important to note that the stated culture must not be a mask for control. If a family says they value education, but just want to control what the child does, the child will feel that distinction, and rebel. Equally, if this church sought to humanly control its members, then it would have failed.

And The LORD Was With Joseph

"And the LORD was with Joseph, and he was a prosperous man; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian."

I have always loved the story of Joseph in the Bible,

but it wasn't until coming to Plainfield that I thought about why the LORD was with Joseph. No matter what came his way, Joseph's love and trust of God never wavered, diminished, or was lost. He never questioned God. He went on, step-by-step, knowing that God was in complete control...a loving merciful God who was and always is available. What a great lesson for us all! ****

JOSEPH'S "ROBE OF SCIENCE"

The "many colors" of Joseph's coat are symbolic of Science (*Science and Health*, p. 568, paragraph heading – "The robe of Science) or what Mrs. Eddy called "truth's prism" (*Science and Health*, p. 556).

Joseph's testing began when his brothers, blinded by jealousy and envy, tore off his "coat of many colors" and sold him into slavery. Joseph's brothers were unable to discern a world beyond their own color-blind, mesmeric, monochromatic viewpoint.

But even as a slave in Egypt, Joseph remained clothed in his right mind, held to the truth that he was created in the image of God, and thus he made sure that his every action in Egypt — no matter how menial — reflected the standards of excellence of the Most High. No matter how difficult the circumstances in which he found himself, Joseph never removed his stately robe of Science, but wrapped himself in it ever more tightly, even after he left his physical garment in the hands of Potiphar's wife, and even after it was exchanged for a drab prison uniform.

We can remember God gives us the faith and understanding to overcome all wrong. Thank God, Christ Jesus, Mrs. Eddy and all who have sacrificed for the Truth to be known. ******
