"This Little Group of Metaphysicians"

From "The Virgin Mary" by Martha Wilcox –

"...sacred history tells us that in this province of Galilee, and among the common people, was a little group of metaphysical thinkers. Right in the midst of this dense materialistic thinking of the upper class, was this little group, this remnant of Israel who practiced pure and undefiled religion. They taught and practiced the most beautiful moral precepts. In fact, they were full of light in that black night of materialism....

"This little remnant of Israel was undiscouraged for Israel's deliverance. Their faith in God was unshaken by the blood ravages of Rome. They worshipped the true God of all the religions of that day; none approached the Hebrew religion in purity of doctrine or cleanness of life as shown forth by this little group of metaphysicians."

The important point here is that this remnant was working and watching from a place of victory, not victimhood. As they grew spiritually, their sense of victory having already been achieved became more real to them than the wretchedness of their physical circumstances. Thus, they gradually removed themselves from the place of emotionally bingeing on how bad things were, the place of powerless complaining and crying out to God. Over time, they were filled with genuine gratitude and appreciation — and even breathless expectancy — for the new outpouring of Light coming upon the earth, calling those "things which be not as though they were." (Romans 4:17.)

They filled themselves with an ever-increasing sense of "Fear not: for they that be with us are more than they that be [against us]." (2 Kings 6:16.) They overwhelmed their doubts by storming them with the promises of God, such as Psalm 27, Psalm 91, and all the songs of the prophets proclaiming the kingdom of God. They watched and prayed from the perspective of glory, not discouragement. This was spiritual warfare waged from the mindset of "It-is-finished: the battle is the Lord's and it's already won," not a far-off victory, but here and now, accepted as a foregone conclusion. (1 Samuel 17:47, 2 Chronicles 20:17.) As Rebecca Greenwood has said, "We pray not for victory, but from victory." This is how a little remnant changed history, brought the Light of Christmas to a darkened world. *******

Give You Another Comforter

"And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;" John 14:16"

Pulpit Commentary

"The greatest Gift – the other Advocate. .. that he may be with you for evermore. ...translate this word "Comforter," "one called in," or "called to the side of another" for the purpose of helping him in any way, ...the rabbinic writers adopt the Greek word פרקליט, in opposition to 'accuser.' ...the only meaning here that is adequate is that of one who pleads, convinces, who strengthens on the one hand, and defends on the other. Christ, as the Advocate, pleads the believer's cause with the Father against the accuser...The Advocate who is to be with the disciples forever, arguing down opposition and silencing cavil, is the Spirit of truth. ...the whole of this passage would read, "He will give you another Helper or Advocate, that he may be with you for ever, even the Spirit of truth whom the world cannot seize (or take from you), because it beholdeth him not, neither knoweth him; but ye

are learning to know him, because he, according to the eternal laws of his being, dwelleth with you, and will be in you, and be altogether beyond the malice of the world."

"In the words of St. John: 'He shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you forever.' This Comforter I understand to be Divine Science." *Science and Health* p. 55 *********

COMFORT (Webster's 1828)

"To strengthen; to invigorate; to cheer or enliven, to console; to give new vigor to the spirits; to relieve from depression, or trouble. The title of the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name—he shall teach you all things. John 14:16."

Before Plainfield, I thought this Comforter was going to bring me a sense of ease, absence of difficulty or effort, no problems. I did not realize that this was impossible because I was seeking ease in sin. It turned out that I needed to face evil; not hide, avoid or run away from it as I was trying to do. This requires understanding how evil operates, how to handle it (prove its nothingness) and keeping a spiritually active thought. In fact, by ignoring evil, I was allowing it to continue. This has been proven each time when I practice the practical Christian Science taught here, where I am finding that even when it seems hard to face evil, there is a strength, peace, and comfort when evil is uncovered and destroyed.

"This spirit of God is made manifest in the flesh, healing and saving men, — it is the Christ, Comforter, 'which taketh away the sin of the world;' and yet Christ is rejected of men! The evil in human nature foams at the touch of good; it crieth out, 'Let us alone; what have we to do with thee, . . . ? art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art; the Holy One of God.' The Holy Spirit takes of the things of God and showeth them unto the creature; and these things being spiritual, they disturb the carnal and destroy it; they are revolutionary, reformatory, and —now, as aforetime — they cast out evils and heal the sick. ...for the spirit giveth him liberty: 'Ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.' Faith/Fear Scale

Say to them that are of a fearful heart, Be strong, fear not. (Isaiah 35: 4)

Zero Faith

"Then Jesus answered and said, O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? bring him hither to me." (Matthew 17:17. See also Mark 9:19, Luke 9:41)

"And he said unto them, Where is your faith?" (Luke 8:25.)

Little Faith

"And he saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith?" (Matthew 8:26; fear and faith cannot exist together as equals)

"O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?" (Matthew 14:31.)

Average Faith

"... according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith." (Romans 12:3 – it's my responsibility to increase this measure as I mature in spirituality: "For if these things be in you and abound [i.e., If you possess these qualities in increasing measure], they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ." (2 Peter 1:8.)

Great Faith

"I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel." (Matthew 8:10.)

"Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour." (Matthew 15:28.)

Full of Faith

"For he was a good man, and full of the Holy Spirit and of faith." (Acts 11:24.)

All Faith

"...though I have all faith so that I could remove mountains ..." (1 Corinthians 13:2.)

The God Kind of Faith

"Have faith in God [more accurately translated 'have the faith of God']. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith." (Mark 11:22-23.)

Will Manifest Myself to Him

John 14:21 He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.(Emphasis added).

So many times we hear about the emphasis on LOVE and how imperative it is to obey that second commandment. The part about the manifestation in the above citation gives me pause to ponder to what extent I was not obeying the commandment to Love and yet was repeating the Scientific Statement of Being (All is Infinite Mind and its Infinite Manifestation) wondering how long a claim would persist, or why I was not seeing the evidence of my prayerful work?
