Having spent most of my life complaining, I am grateful to be learning constructive positive healing habits and attitudes based on Mrs. Eddy's Science of the Christ, correctly taught at Plainfield Independent Church. Monday, I came across the Watch below from 500 Watching Points by Gilbert

Carpenter which seems to go with what the people leaving Egypt were struggling with. I found it a helpful instruction, especially in light of the human desire for ease, and the world telling us that ease is spiritual not to be challenged. This ease puts you to sleep, unlike the peace that comes from obedience to God.

"120 — WATCH lest, having put your hand to the plough, you look back. The action and effect of Truth is to uncover and destroy error. A plough turns over the topsoil and exposes that which has been hidden. The tendency of the human mind is to desire everything smooth on the surface, even though, underneath, there is hidden latent error.

If a student is not ready to stick to the plough after it has begun to uncover error, and continue the warfare until the error is entirely exposed and destroyed, he is not ready to put his hand to the plough at all, in order that Truth may uncover his hidden errors. He will look back with desire at the time when he enjoyed human harmony, even though there was hidden error in his thought.

"What Agreement Hath The Temple of God with Idols?"

GOLDEN TEXT: II CORINTHIANS 6: 16 "And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people."

I never have thought of it quite in this way before: I, being "the temple of the living God," am made by God for Him to "dwell in [me], and walk in [me]." God has not agreed to let any idols, false beliefs, or error to reside in, or make use of His temple, so if they are in there it must have been the temple itself – me! – who allowed them access. cit. 4. 119: 1-5 (to,)

"When we endow matter with vague spiritual power, — that is, when we do so in our theories, for of course we cannot really endow matter with what it does not and cannot possess, — we disown the Almighty,"

The 1828 Webster's defines disown as "To deny; not to own; to refuse to acknowledge as belonging

to ones self." That thought of disowning God really hit me today! No wonder I felt so lost and alone before coming to Plainfield! I was doing my best to disown Truth, Love, Life, Mind, good, and reality! Talk about moral idiocy!

I am so grateful to Christian Science, this church, and practitioner support for showing me bit-by-bit how to recognize right thoughts, how to "Stand porter at the door of thought," (*Science and Health*, p. 392) and how to accept and hold sacred the fact that I am God's and there is no other place for me to be, and none other that should dwell in me. Ooops, Did I Make My Body An Idol?

How much are the thoughts about my body occupying my thinking everyday? Does my body not get enough time while I get ready for the day? Should I spend any more time dwelling on every wrinkle, every pound I gain, every pimple, every ache or pain?

Idol. Webster 1828 4. Any thing on which we set our affections; that to which we indulge an excessive and sinful attachment. Little children, keep yourselves from *idols*. 1 John 5:21

An *idol* is any thing which **usurps the place of God in the hearts of his rational creatures.** (Emphasis added.)

I have learned we have more idols than one would believe; examples are our bodies, personalities, habitual thoughts that consume us, desired ambitions that occupy our thoughts, others' faults that dominate us, false beliefs that we allow to discourage, belittle, frustrate, anger us or conduct our lives other than the love of God. And are any of these worth it? No!! Thus we should heed 1 John 5:21 Little children, keep yourselves from idols. Amen.

We have been given a way out of being idolaters: That is to get the correct view of your immortal self-hood, to see that you are an embodiment of right ideas, spiritual, made perfect in the image and likeness of God! Preoccupying thought with this would help us be present with the Lord and absent from the material sense of body. *********

And also, "Matter...in which paganism and LUST are so sanctioned by society that mankind has caught their moral contagion." (emphasis added)

Webster defines "lust" as carnal (fleshly) appetite or desire; deprayed affections and desires.

Am I "lusting" for food, fashion, physique, or a glamorous enhancement of my body or home? These are all "sanctioned by society" and so easy to get caught up in, unless I constantly strive to "see that you are an embodiment of right ideas, spiritual, made perfect in the image and likeness of God!" Such a helpful Lesson-Sermon to remind me what's really important.

"For Such A Time As This"

"... Soul is Substance, and body its idea ... [D]isease is not in the idea of Soul or immortality, nor can it exist in shadow, the body of Soul, therefore it has no existence."

(Science and Health, first edition, p. 430.)

Consider the magnificence, the sovereignty, majesty and dominion of the sun in its relationship to earth: earth's influence upon the sun is minuscule in contrast to the sun's influence upon earth. Think of the vast differences between these two heavenly bodies, in size, substance, positions in space relative to one another, etc.

Soul does not — cannot — inhabit body any more than the sun can fit inside the earth, which is an utter impossibility. Sun ruling day upon earth is symbol of Soul governing body.

Nevertheless, for how many centuries did humans reverse the roles of sun and earth, Soul and body, supposing the greater to be subject to the lesser, the Creator to the creature?

"Give up the belief that mind is, even temporarily, compressed within the skull, and ... [y]ou will understand yourself and your Maker better than before." (*Science and Health*, page 397.)

As the cold earth automatically allows the sun to bathe it in warmth and radiance, so I must dedicate myself to being continually present with Soul, single-mindedly turning to the light of Life, Truth, Love, which also means being absent from the body, that is, to close my mind to "that of which immortal Mind takes no cognizance." (*Science and Health*, page 591.)

Likewise, "for such a time as this," all who are striving to establish identification with the regiments of "the woman clothed with the sun . . . and the remnant of her seed" are required to follow her impersonal example, because all must be clothed in the light of the "Sun of Righteousness" — clad in "the Robe of Science" — so that multitudes may touch the hems of such garments . . . and live. (Esther 4:13-14; Rev. 12; *Science and Health*, page 569.)
