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SUBJECT: Love — January 30th, 2022

Everlasting Love

From the Lesson:

"The LORD hath appeared of old unto me, *saying*, Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love..." (Jeremiah 31:3)

"Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us..." (I John 4:10)

In the July 2019 issue of 'Love is the Liberator', is an article from the Christian Science Journal, 1885, entitled "Childlike Trust." It tells of a little child confidently treating and healing a little boy, with a violent form of illness; and when asked how she did it, she explained that she "just remembered for him that God loved him dearly..."

Divine Love: Thou Art That

(Guiding Text): "He that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?" (*Science and Health, p.* 366:14-16; 1 John 4:20).

This post relies upon divine science wisdom to answer the mighty apostolic question quoted above by St. John and Mary Baker Eddy. Concisely, personal sense, to varying degrees of intensity (emotionalism), is attached to the erroneous belief that a person, animal, even a place or thing has inherent powers of love and hate (good and evil) (see Ret: 65-6; *S&H* 1875: Ch. 1; *S&H* 71:1-4). Sit tight: That love is found in a finite-matter-bound form is a limited human concept. All great prophets declare that human love appears to be real, yet is unreal (see *S&H*: 268-340). So, personal sense can provide no solution to loving 'brother' whom I have seen!

That said, Love is God, Spirit, Soul. Divine Love abides in Soul in its FULLNESS, nonetheless "none but the pure in heart can see God" (Matt. 5:8). Christ Awareness is that pure heart outside of personal sense and material form. The science of being rests upon the Principle that "I" is divine Love, Spirit, Immortal Being, not matter, not personality (see *Science and Health* 1875:60-1;40-1;198-9; Ret: 29).

I understand the lived experience of Christ's Sermon on the Mount, as Jesus promises, will reveal divine Love, even as a flash of Christ Awareness, and will become a fount of inspiration, or the key to the door through which "I" (Spirit) will be enabled to meet in Oneness with My Father (Spirit) in Heaven (Immortality) (see Matthew 5:1-48-6:8-34; 7:1-29; see *Science and Health* 1875: 211-3; Ret: 86-7).

The outstanding point in this lesson to me is that divine Love is not of 'this world'. A deeper point is my scientific understanding of Christ will be multiplied as 'loaves and fishes', casting out error, teaching the gospel and healing the sick, only in proportion as I am able to experience divine Love via my Awareness of Oneness: "I and my Father are one" (John 10:30). And, a deeper point still, there is not God and 'brother' in Oneness. All there is to 'brother' is Soul, Spirit, Love, not person in any finite sense of the word (see *Science & Health* 1875: Ch. 3; 211-2; 223; *S&H* 71:1-9; Ret: 83-4).

If God Be For Us, Who Can Be Against Us?

(Responsive Reading: Romans 8:31) "If God be for us, who can be against us?"

Watching Point 399 — WATCH that you seek to love others, rather than to seek to have others love you. When you seek to have others love you, you are clinging to earth. When you seek to love others, without regard for whether that love is returned, you are on the highroad to heaven. Mrs. Eddy once said, "In human love you seek someone to love; in divine Love you seek to love." At another time she said, "In human love you expect something for yourself; in divine Love you expect something for all."

Live And Walk In Spirit

(Golden Text: Galatians 5:25) "If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit". The word "if" qualifies a direction and an instruction, and informs us the request that follows

is important.

The term "let us" is conditional and draws us to what we are asked to do by way of application and practice.

Thus, "if" we live (that is, when we truly understand and abide) in the Spirit, (which is the Principle of Immortal Life and of At-one-ment), "let us" ALSO "walk in the Spirit": that is, practise, wholeheartedly, the precepts and commandments Jesus of Nazareth declares are essential principles, because as we truly master them we are able to understand Christ Awareness, and therefore are able to demonstrate and prove that personal sense and error have no Scientific basis.

'Science and Health' is a guiding light to each step we take spiritually, and when we walk in line with it and Scripture, we are invited to correct our direction and adjust our pace to match those of Soul, Spirit, and immortal Life.

"Mother Was Trying to Give You Her Highest Teaching."

In reading Watching Point 269 from the Daily Watch this week, the following from pages 252-253 of the Divinity Course and General Collectanea, (the Blue Book), came to me: "One day Mrs. Eddy touched Adam Dickey's hand with her finger and asked him, 'What is this?' He replied, 'Matter.' She said, 'It is not; it is Spirit'. Then another time she looked at him and said, 'You are Spirit'. And he said, 'No, Mother, I am spiritual'. She said in a very emphatic way, 'You are Spirit'. And he said, 'Mother, I do not see that'. She said, 'You are Spirit', the third time, but he said he could not see it. When he was going to his room he met Mrs. Sargent and told her of the conversation with Mrs. Eddy and she said, 'Oh, Mr. Dickey, why did you say that! Mother was trying to give you her highest teaching." *****

In contemplating this Watching Point and above quote more this week, I was thinking of everything I didn't understand when I first arrived in Plainfield. (Practically everything!) But my

practitioner let me know these things would become clear over time, and clearer still as we progress. And true to that, I am sure everyone can relate to reading or hearing something from a lesson or one of our books and eventually it finally clicks. To have these ideas open up and become something we rely on in our daily lives is such a great blessing. Because of this, I've begun to see that "demanding the blessing" actually comes in two parts: The first is to know that all situations and interactions have good to impart, and to pray and work and strive and be patient until it is revealed. The second — which I am not sure I was completely doing for a long while — is to not just be content with the uncovering of that good, but to actively work to accept that blessing within myself so that it becomes yet another tool I have proved and can use, as needed.

In thinking of Mrs. Eddy teaching Adam Dickey, she uncovered this great good for him, yet it was as if he demanded not to be blessed. How much better if he had said "I will quiet my doubt and trust your spiritual understanding over my own, and pray I understand this with time." I feel this is an important thing for me to be on the lookout for in myself. Just because and I am here in Plainfield even as Adam Dickey worked for Mrs. Eddy at Chestnut Hill — it does not mean the entirety of my consciousness is good soil, or that I don't have more to learn. There may (will?) be patches of thorns or rocky ground which I will need to contend with, so more advanced teachings of Christian Science will be able to take root in me and flourish. This reminds me of Mary Baker Eddy's words from page 118 from *Misc*: "Be of good cheer; the warfare with one's self is grand; it gives one plenty of employment, and the divine Principle worketh with you, — and obedience crowns persistent effort with everlasting victory."

I am so grateful for all that I am learning here each week. Thank you!
