The Difference Between Benediction and Malediction

Genesis 3:16, 17, 19: "Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire *shall be* to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee. And unto Adam he said,...In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou *art*, and unto dust shalt thou return."

Each week we end the Sunday service with a benediction ("The act of blessing; a giving praise to God or rendering thanks for his favors; a blessing pronounced.")

Reading the above verse, however, reminded me of the word 'malediction' and its definition "Evil speaking; denunciation of evil; a cursing; curse or execration." What an awful law it would pronounce on us, if it had power beyond what we have given it. I am grateful to Christian Science, this Church, and practitioner support for showing me how to "Stand porter at the door of thought," (Science and Health, p. 392) to discern the difference between benediction and malediction — reality from unreality — and to only accept the good and true that come from God into my thought. Thank you!

Science of Christianity

In this week's Lesson, it says in citation 14, *S&H* p. 473:26, 28-31: "Jesus established what he said by demonstration, ...He proved what he taught. This is the Science of Christianity. Jesus *proved* the Principle, which heals the sick and casts out error, to be divine."

And in the April 30th Watch, Bicknell Young's statement from "Idea" really struck me: "No church in the world can give proof of its utility as long as there is no scientific Christianity."

To really get a grasp on this, I looked up "science" and "scientific."

In the 1981 Webster's:

"science" is defined: "a possession of knowledge as distinguished from ignorance or misunderstanding. Knowledge attained through study or practice."

"scientific": "exhibiting the methods or principles of science."

In the 1828 Webster's:

"science": "In a general sense, knowledge, or certain knowledge; the comprehension or understanding of truth or facts by the mind. The science of God must be perfect."

"scientific": "producing certain knowledge or demonstration; as scientific evidence."

Thank goodness that Jesus proved the Truth and set an example; and Mary Baker Eddy explained that through spiritual sense we can all understand and do the works!

Self Mastery

Materialism Denounced

Mrs. Eddy's precious instruction regarding the error and nothingness of materialism is echoed in a 2013 book: *The Experience of God*. I do not know if the author, David Bentley Hart, read *Science and Health*, but the formulations by this Orthodox Christian thinker resound with CS expositions on God and man.

To wit:

- Materialists are mad fanatics with an infinite appetite for paradox, whereas God is the unity of consciousness.
- God is not merely one, but oneness, the source of everything.
- God is the one act of being and consciousness.
- Mind is everywhere.
- God is both the knower and the known, infinite intelligence and infinite intelligibility.
- Atheism is another name for radical absurdism.
 There can be no mechanistic account for consciousness.
- Soul is the form of the body (Aristotle).

I am so grateful for Mrs. Eddy's discovery of Christian Science, as it continues to open and deepen channels of right thinking in the world.

Go, Call Thy Husband, and Come Hither (John 4:16)

In trying to better understand the conversation between Jesus and the woman of Samaria, I liked this part of the Commentary from the 'Cambridge Bible for Schools and Colleges', enlarging on why Jesus asked the woman to 'call [her] husband and come hither.'

"[Go, call thy husband] - Not that the man was wanted, either as a concession to Jewish propriety, which forbad a Rabbi to talk with a woman alone, or for any other reason. By a seemingly casual request Christ lays hold of her inner life, convinces her of sin, and leads her to repentance, without which her request, 'Give me this water,' could not be granted. The husband who was no husband was the plague-spot where her healing must begin."

Shape Our Views

"Life is eternal. We should find this out, and begin the demonstration thereof. Life and goodness are immortal. Let us then shape our views of existence into loveliness, freshness, and continuity, rather than into age and blight." *Science and Health* by Mary Baker Eddy, p. 246

This lesson perfectly follows last week's Bible lesson and the coordinating Roundtable. We are to see as God sees us and all creation – "shape our views" in line with Christian Science. It brought joy to review the meanings of the following words to gain a deeper appreciation of what God has created.

"Continuity: Connection uninterrupted, ceaseless. Freshness: Not stale, sour, decayed; unimpaired, not altered, made anew, free from taint. Loveliness: Harmony, lovable, beauty." (Webster's 1828 Dictionary)

Mortals and immortals, what does God know about this? I saw this mortal mind constantly projecting its own mirage-world or creation of discords, sin, disease and death, war and sufferings untold. When I saw a room full of people receiving chemotherapy, poison poured into their veins, my soul cried out, O my God, how far have we strayed from You, source of all

goodness and blessing! The divine Mind could ask: Where is there something wrong? Is it here? That is impossible, because I am here, omnipresent Good. Is it over there? No way, I am there too. I am everywhere mortal mind is not. Mortal mind is the omni-absence of Omnipresence. God's thoughts should be omnipresent in my mind, creating in me a kingdom of harmony and health. When we think as God thinks, we find God taking place. It all takes place in our inner being, or thinking and feeling. Omnipresence is omnipotence, Truth, and Love, All-in-all. For of Mind, and through Mind, and to Mind, is All. (Romans 11:36) Thank God we have not to struggle with matter, or with a reality. We just must allow Mind to be omnipresent as us. Find yourself as Mind.

All Food Comes from Mind

From *Mary Baker Eddy, Her Spiritual Precepts*, by Gilbert Carpenter:

"When one eats from the standpoint that what he has eaten is a product of earth and was raised by man's patience and skill, he loses sight of the fact that every good gift and every perfect gift cometh down from the Father of lights. The food may appear to come from beneath, but in reality it comes from above. When Jesus fed the five thousand, he demonstrated that the earth never

created food. Just as the ventriloquist's dummy is used to deceive people into thinking that it is the source of the former's voice, so mortal mind uses the land and sea to deceive mortals into believing that these are the sources of bread and fish.

The food that we eat every day is manna from heaven as truly as was the food that sustained the Children of Israel in the wilderness. The fact that they picked it up off the ground, whereas we grow ours from seed, does not alter the fact that all food comes from Mind.

Mrs. Eddy's message was manna from heaven that carried the spirit of healing; but because it was appropriated by mortal thought, it appeared to come from the ground of a trained mortal intelligence, and so carried scant spiritual uplift or healing. Even though Mrs. Eddy made the demonstration to receive it from heaven, the good was almost lost because it was appropriated by mortal mind.

The food that sustained the Children of Israel came down from heaven. In Deuteronomy 8, we find a warning that in the process of time the temptation would come to believe that food came as the result of mortal man's skill and intelligence, rather than the demonstration of God's giving. So it becomes necessary to state that it is not material food that sustains man's life, but the thought back of it, the Mind of God that accompanies it. It is the task of the student of Christian Science to learn to receive the Spirit of God through every human channel, since only in that way will he become a perpetual recipient of God's constant blessings, which bring to man all that he needs to sustain him.

The Children of Israel admitted that the food they gathered and called manna was a vehicle which carried the Mind of God. Today we must extend this admission to cover everything."

Let us always sense the Causative Principle, Spirit, impartial and immortal. The Principle that produces form is invisible to finite sense, yet it is "seen" by spiritual sense. Real Joy is "seeing" God's glory showing forth God's glory!

Soul Expresses Itself

The First Edition has very clear, strong statements. From our textbook: "Love God...the surrender of all merely material sensation, affection and worship. Mortal existence is a state of self-deception, this so-called mind produces all that is unlike the immortal Mind. The corporeal senses are the only source of evil or error." I have struggled long and hard with these statements. The depraved appetites are, of course, not material substances because there are none but wrong ideas, indulging in the unreal ideas or misconceptions of mortal mind.

I just re-read an article that I feel comes more down to the human, present level. It is "The Lame Walk" by Rev. G.A. Kratzer. It must be somewhere on our website. A lot of wrong thinking, and thus acting, must come from our mortal sense of lack: a lack of love, goodness, truth. We accept the reality of this unreal world and material selfhood, while infinite creation is nothing but the divine Consciousness, eternal Love. We must experience this Love, reflect it back to God, and Be it. God needs our love! It takes constant watchfulness. I must stop giving reality to that which has no Cause, no Creator, no Thinker.

It makes no difference what we wish to draw from within ourselves (immortality, infinity, well-being, supply, joy, love, intelligence), it is already there. Peacefully and calmly, Christ Science "enlightens" the prodigal of his divine inheritance that is already there.

What Shall a Man Give in Exchange for His Soul?

"For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?" (Matt. 16)

The Waters of Soul

In Isaiah 11:6-9, there is mention of different classes of animals, not at all like the ones we are used to. Heaven and earth shall pass away... Is it the projection of the human, mortal mind that shall pass away, because it never was? The more I read things in the news about all the horrible things that seem to be going on all around the world, the more I understand this all must be a mirage, an unreality, the projection of the mortal, malicious human mind. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain; for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of God, as the waters cover the sea.

Knowing God implies knowing what God knows. ... but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water SPRINGING UP into everlasting life.

Yes, we gaze upon the ugliness of the Adam dream and that, we learn in Science, IS a dream, an illusion, although appearing to be real. There is no rectifying a dream. Our reality lies in maintaining our Oneness with the Father and thank God this is possible for us all here and now due to the teachings of the Master and Mary Baker Eddy. And so we can experience heaven on earth. The sexual element you mentioned in your other post is also part of the Adam dream and as you explained, some forms of it definitely appear better than others. It is the love, the closeness, the joy of any experience which makes it border on the divine and this is what people truly seek after. All things human, however, must pass away but the good that God gives remains with us forever – and isn't that wonderful?

The picture shown in Isaiah 11:6-9 feels like what it will be when every creature looks to God alone for all they need and therefore know no lack, fear, division, or hate. This must be why Christ Jesus told us to "preach the gospel to every creature." (Mark 16: 15) Until this picture – which Mrs. Eddy called "The Millennium" – is what we see in the world, the following quote, and similar, are what I have been working with while handling the unreal mortal mind images:

"Watch that you do not lose your love from the attacks of hate. Better lose life in matter than love for God and man. This is why our dear departed are better blessed than those that remain if they are returning evil for evil."

"Let our finite judgment never settle on who is troubling us, and never defend ourselves against a person. Rather ask what is troubling, and then meet the what."
