

STRENGTH IN UNITY

I was grateful for a reminder from a letter I read the other day of what transpired here at Plainfield and how we managed to survive the attacks from Boston and went forward to thrive. There is one major reason why this church did survive, and it was because of Mrs. Evans and her husband.

Their love for Mary Baker Eddy and dedication to this Cause was something to behold. They both were healers. Mrs. Evans certainly healed quite a number of cases that were considered amazing and that attracted many people to the area.

People began to move to Plainfield. Houses were refurbished and fixed up, so people could live in what we called church houses. We would have what we called work parties where we worked together in unity.

The Watches began. Twenty-four hours a day, someone would be doing a

Watch. Of course, we were under attack by the Boston Board, but we persevered and we worked through all of that. I refer to that time as a boot camp for Christian Scientists. It was intensive; we had classes every week. There was tremendous growth. We were not just reading about it, we had to live it. If you didn't live it, you weren't going to be around long.

In living it that way, tremendous growth resulted. We are not really sure if Mrs. Evans always knew exactly what was going to happen to this church, but she did have a core of workers who survived it all and continued it. Now we are passing it on. It is the true Christian Science; it is how it heals and transforms lives. It is not about waving a magic wand and getting your instantaneous healing. It is much deeper than that. I am very grateful to Mr. and Mrs. Evans for what they did and for what they sacrificed.

This did not just take a year or two; it took many years of being under the gun in that respect. I often think of the preface in Miscellaneous Writings, where Mrs. Eddy writes, "To preserve a long course of years still and uniform, amid the uniform darkness of storm and cloud and tempest, requires strength from above, — deep draughts from the fount of divine Love." That is how we survived, by drinking, "...deep drafts of divine Love," by maintaining our unity, and by keeping our focus, by our Watches. Thank God for it!
