Recently an idea came to print the Forum Highlights in "quarterly" sections and offer them as available gifts, as we do the calendars. Price has not been determined yet, and we would appreciate some feedback on this.

Sincere thanks to Wendy and Jeffrey for their dedication in editing the highlights; and to Lillian and Jeremy for getting them printed and mailed out to our readers in a timely manner. Much gratitude to all who take time to write on the Forum.

Just since our last Membership Meeting in May, our website, plainfieldcs.com, has had 5,197 different visitors from 117 different countries, who looked at over 90,000 pages.

On YouTube, we now have 1,782 videos posted online, which have been viewed 33,951 times for 166,638 minutes watched. And we have 230 YouTube subscribers worldwide. These numbers have increased dramatically since our May meeting. So please keep up your prayerful support that people will be led to our website, and be blessed.

Facebook has 149 followers, and SoundCloud has had 8,183 plays and 215 likes from 195 different countries. That is 1,863 more than in May!!

We continue with the building of the new version of the church website. Since September of last year, over 4 million lines of code have gone into the new website. The main page of the old website took over 16 seconds to load—but the new version of the website loads in less than one second.

And we now have three translation sections on the website for Dutch, Spanish, and French translations of Lessons, articles, etc. These have only been operating since July, but already the Dutch site has had 50 different visitors, the French has had 59, and the Spanish has had 1,809 different visitors!

There are a few people testing the new version of the store on our website, which will be usable when the testing is completed.

We are very grateful for all those involved in every aspect of the church website.
